- PLAYer Advanced** – PLAYer Completed or First time participant age 13+ years old
- PAR** – PLAYer Certified and 9+ years old
- PAR Advanced** – Par Completed and 9+ years old
- PAR Golf Skills** – Par Advanced Completed and 10+ years old
- LPGA-USGA Girls Golf** – Must have completed at least ONE certification class and Female
- BIRDIE**- Par Certified and 11+ years old
- BIRDIE Advanced** – Birdie Completed and 11+ years old
- BIRDIE Golf Skills** – Birdie/Birdie Advanced Completed and 12+ years old
- EAGLE** – Birdie Certified, 13+ years old
- EAGLE Advanced**– Eagle completed, 13+ years old, or Advanced Placement by Coach
- EAGLE Golf Skills** – Eagle/Eagle Advanced completed, 14+ years old
- ACE** – Eagle Certified, 15+ years old and Coach Recommended, Home Office Approved

Payment must be made at the time the application is submitted, unless the student is requesting a Fee scholarship.
